Annual Administrative Report of the Assam State Agricultural Marketing Board for the year 2008-2009

Introduction:

The Assam Agricultural Produce Market Act.1972 has been implemented in Assam with effect from 15-6-1977 with the objective of regulation of buying and selling of agricultural produces and also to establish an efficient marketing system where the growers may obtain reasonable and competitive price of their produce. The purpose is also to establish modern market yards where scientific godowns, platforms for auction of commodities, storage facilities, traders shop, bank and post office, parking places, provision of drinking water etc. are provided in the market yards through the Market Committees established at different places of the State under provisions of the Assam Agricultural Produce Market Act.1972. The schemes have been implemented through the Market Committees under supervision, control and guidance of the Assam State Agricultural Marketing Board.

The Assam State Agricultural Marketing Board with its head quarter at Guwahati is a statutory and apex body established for exercising superintendence and control over the Market Committee, the agencies responsible for successful implementation of the scheme in the field.

The Market Board was constituted vide Govt. notification No.AGA/616/75/90 dated 24/09/1976 and the first meeting was held on 26-02-77.

The last Board was constituted under provisions of section 3 (I) (a) of the Assam Agricultural Produce Market Act.1972 (as amended in 2006) by the Government of Assam with the following members, head by Sri Debeswar Borah, Ex-MLA as Chairman of the Board, vide Govt. notification No.AGA 337/2001/Pt/12, dt.15-12-2005 and functioned till 21-01-2009.

The Government has not re-constituted the Board till date instead appointed a Director for functioning of the Board since 22-01-2009.

In order to safeguard the interest of growers and traders the Govt. of Assam has constituted 24 nos. of Regulated Market Committee all over the State with 20 nos. of Principal Market Yards and 206 nos. of Sub-Market Yards in different Districts/ Sub-Divisions of the State.

Initially the Government of Assam as well as the Government of India provided financial assistance to the Market Board against implementation of scheme and meet the maintenance cost of staff etc. At present the Assam State Agricultural Marketing Board has taken up various infrastructure development works and other beneficiary schemes from its own source of income. However, the Assam State Agricultural Marketing Board has received assistance/subsidy from Govt. of India and NEC against certain schemes such as Technology Mission (MM-III), Rural Godown, MRIN, construction of Cold Storage and allied marketing facilities etc. The Govt. of India approved Rs. 2,87,50,000.00 for development of 25 rural markets and 2 wholesale markets in the year 2002 in 50:50 ratio against Mini Mission-III. The State Agricultural Marketing Board received Rs. 2,03,75,000.00 (first instalment of Rs. 1,43,75,000.00 and second instalment of Rs. 60,00,000.00) and made expenditures of Rs. 2,00,87,000.00 till November, 2008.

The Assam State Agricultural Marketing Board submitted 19 Schemes for development of rural market to the Govt. of India for sanction. The Govt. of India has sanctioned 6 schemes for development of rural markets in the year 2006-07 and released Rs. 22,50,000.00 as first instalment and made expenditure of Rs. 22,50,000.00 till November, 2008.

The Board received financial assistances from N.E.C. for construction of Cold Storage at Singimari and Gossaigaon. The Govt. of India sanction the project "Improvement of Jute Market Yard at Kharupetia" under the scheme of Mini Mission-III of Jute Technology Mission at project cost of Rs.1,00,00,000.00 at ratio 60:40 (60% Central share and 40% Market Board's share).

The Govt. of Assam sanctioned the following schemes under the Rastriya Krishi Vikash Yojana 2008-09 at the cost of Rs.10,00,00,000.00 and handed over the scheme to the Assam State Agricultural Marketing Board for execution.

- 1. Establishment of Organic Agriculture Produces Market Complex at Six mile Guwahati for Rs.7,00.00,000.00.
- 2. Development of Principal Market Yard, Golaghat Regulated Market Committee at Furkating for Rs. 1,50,00,000.00.

3. Development of Mahtoli (Sontoli) Market under G.S.M.C. for Rs.1,50,00,000.00

The Regulated Market Committees and the Board levy cess on the agricultural produce bought or sold in the market area at the rate of one rupee for every one hundred rupees of the aggregate amount for which a notified agricultural produce is bought or sold as the source of income for implementation of the provision of Act and benefiting the agriculturist and trader of the state. Administrative setup:

As per Section 3 (1) of the Assam Agricultural Produce Market Act, 1972 as amended up to 2006 and under Rule 6 (1) of Assam Agricultural Produce Market (General) Rules, 1975 as amended up to 2003, the Chairman is the head of the Board and he is responsible for administration of the Assam Agricultural Produce Market Act and he is to exercise general control over the employees of the Board and Market Committees. The Chairman is also to exercise over-all supervision on the Market Committees under provisions of the Act and Rules.

As per provision under the Assam Agricultural Produce Market Act, 1972 as amended up to 2006, the Chief Executive Officer of the Board is appointed by the State Govt. He is the head of the office of the Board having the general control over the employees of the Board and Market Committees and he is to act as the Ex-Officio Member-secretary of the Board.

There are five different branches to assist the Chief Executive Officer in implementation of provisions of the Act, Rules & Bye-laws framed there under as stated below. The activities so far performed during the year 2008-09 are also narrated in brief against each of the branches.

Development branch:

This branch is headed by the Deputy Chief Executive Officer. The branch is responsible for developmental activities of the regulated markets in the state. The details of activities performed under this branch during the year 2008-09 are furnished as below.

<u>Cess Collection</u>:- The Market Committee is levying market cess on bought or sold of specified Agricultural produce within the market area as per section 21 of Assam Agricultural Produce market Act, 1972.

Total Cess Collected during the year 2008-09 is Rs. 29,88,22,289.00.

Agricultural Market Reforms:- The Assam Agricultural Produce Market Act, 1972 has already been amended as a part of agricultural market reforms in the light of Model Act circulated by Government of India. The amendment of the Assam Agricultural Produce Market (General) Rules as per Model Act circulated by Government of India is also ready for submission to the Government of Assam. The amended Act has allowed Contract Farming, establishment of Private Market, Consumer/Farmer Market and Direct purchase from the agriculturists.

Engineering branch:

The Engineering branch of the Assam State Agricultural Marketing Board is consisting of 4 (four) divisions and are controlled by 2 (two) Executive Engineers, 1 (one) Project Engineer, 1 (one) Assistant Executive Engineer and 4 (four) Assistant Engineers in the Board's Office and the works at sites are supervised by Junior Engineers and Sectional Assistants posted in the market committees.

During the financial year 2007-08, almost all on going works from the last financial year have been completed. Besides this several development works under ADF/M.C.'s fund have been taken up in the PMY's as well as in the existing markets under the jurisdiction of respective market committees.

Establishment of a Terminal Market near Amingaon with project cost Rs.186.00 Crore is in active consideration with some progress regarding allotment of land for the same. Development of single commodity market at Darrangiri (for Banana) and at Karikhana (for molasses) is also under consideration.

Information & Publicity branch:

This branch is headed by a Publicity Officer and he is assisted by one Assistant Publicity Officer, one Assistant Liaison Officer and few other Assistants. This branch undertakes publicity, extension, dissemination and liaison activities of the Board.

Accounts branch:

The Accounts branch of the Assam State Agricultural Marketing Board is functioning under the supervision and guidance of 2 (two) Chief Accounts Officers assisted by 2 (two) Accounts officers, 5 (five) Accountant (one for Srirampur c/g) and few other Accounts Assistants. There are also 1 (one) Sr. Audit Officer and 2 (two) Internal Auditors in this branch. As per provisions under the Assam Agricultural Produce Market Act.1972 (as amended up to 2006), the Board and the market committees under it are following the financial rules of the Govt. of Assam and the instructions and circulars issued in this regard by the Govt. of Assam from time to time.

The Accounts maintained by the Marketing Board and Regulated market Committees are audited by the Internal Auditors of the Board and Statutory Audit and also Chartered Accountant for preparing Balance sheets of the Board and Regulated Market Committees.

Administrative branch:

This branch is headed by an Administrative Officer, next to him there are one assistant Administrative Officer, Superintendents and other Assistants. This branch is responsible for execution of day to day establishment matters like maintenance of attendance Register of the employees, granting of leave, increment, promotion, appointment, transfer & posting and other service matters of employees of the Board and market committees under it.

Regulated Market Committees:

In 1972 the Assam Agricultural Produce Market Act was passed by the State Legislative Assembly and from 1976 the Regulated Market Scheme was introduced in the State with the formation of State Agricultural Marketing Board and the Regulated Market Committees (known as APMCs in other States) at different places in the State with the objective of regulation of buying and selling of agricultural produces to eradicate malpractices prevailing in the trade in urban, semi-urban and rural markets and also to establish an efficient marketing system, where the growers may obtain reasonable and competitive price and the traders receive a fair deal in trading. The purpose is also to establish a modern market yard, where scientific godowns for storage, platforms for auction of agricultural commodities, display yards, traders shop, banks and post offices, are provided with. The scheme has been implemented by the Assam State Agricultural Marketing Board through Market Committees established in different areas of the State.
